Workshops Essayer

Heart Kumihimo Bracelet



Supplies

- Kumihimo disk
- 2 Colors of string
- Clasp
- Scissors
- Liquid glue

Steps

- 1. Cut 5 lengths of one color string and 1 length of the other color string to slightly less than your wingspan.
- 2. Group the 6 strings together, and thread one half of the clasp onto them. Place the clasp in the middle and tie a knot to secure it.
- 3. Place the clasp in the center hole of the Kumihimo disk.
- 4. Arrange the strings so there are two base color strings on either side of the top dot, one base color string on either side of the left and right dots, one heart color string on either side of the bottom dot, and one base color string on either side of the heart color strings. (Figure 1)
- 5. Move the string to the immediate right of the top dot to the next free space below the left dot. (Figure 2)
- 6. Move the string to the immediate left of the top dot to the next free space below the right dot. (Figure 3)
- 7. Move the string to the immediate right of the bottom dot to the next free space above the left dot. (Figure 4)
- 8. Move the string to the immediate left of the bottom dot to the next free space above the right dot. (Figure 5)
- Move the strings near the top and bottom dots one space closer to the dot. (Will now be immediately next to the dot.) (Figure 6)
- 10. Move the string immediately above the left dot to the next free space to the left of the bottom dot. (Figure 7)

- 11. Move the string immediately above the right dot to the next free space to the right of the bottom dot. (Figure 8)
- 12. Move the string immediately below the left dot to the next free space to the left of the top dot. (Figure 9)
- 13. Move the string immediately below the right dot to the next free space to the right of the top dot. (Figure 10)
- 14. Move the strings near the left and right dots in one space closer to the dot. (Will now be immediately next to the dot.)
 (Figure 11)
- 15. Repeat steps 5-14 until the desired length is reached.

- 16. Remove all the strings from the disk.
- 17. Gather the strings together, and thread the other half of the clasp onto them. Tie a knot to secure the clasp. Use a dab of glue to secure the knot.

Tips

Make sure to keep the strings tight to the disk.

A thicker string will produce larger heart
